- 4. Articulate in a precise and consistent musical manner on their instruments (Goal 2a)
- 5. Display acceptable control of dynamic levels on their instruments

- 1. The daily rehearsals and sectionals held periodically will show the progress of each band member.
- 2. Band members must participate and perform at dress rehearsals, concerts, and recording sessions as part of their grade.
