Normandale is a recipient of federal funds as a part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act passed by the United States Congress in March 2020. Colleges and universities have received CARES Act funds to directly assist students who may be experiencing financial hardship as a result of COVID-19.

Eligible students will receive a payment by direct deposit to a banking account or a check mailed to your permanent address on record. **To speed up your distribution of funds**, we encourage you to sign up for Direct Deposit no later than 4 pm on Thursday, May 6. Normandale was a recipient of federal funds as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act passed by the United States Congress in March 2020. Colleges and universities have received CARES Act funds to directly assist students who may be experiencing financial hardship as a result of COVID-19.

All Federal Pell Grant recipients who were enrolled at Normandale as of March 6, 2020 and meet Department of Education and Minnesota State eligibility requirements will receive \$600 in emergency funds. The funds will be issued to you by direct deposit or check.

Direct Deposit funds can take up to two business days to show up in your account. If you are not receiving funds through Direct Deposit, please make sure your correct address is updated here.

If you are attending more than one Minnesota State college or university, you may only receive a CARES Award from one school. All awards are dependent upon <u>eligibility</u>.

If you need additional financial support, funds are available through the Normandale Cares grant program. These funds are for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19, which include the cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and child care.

Student emergency grants of up to \$500 are available with the ability to reapply every 30 days for a maximum total of \$2,000 per student, as funds are available.
