

How to Apply?

Step 1:	Complete the General Application for Admission to Normandale
Step 2:	Complete Pre-Requisite Courses and other Program Admissions Requirements <i>For more information, please review the Nursing Pre-Admissions Packet, the nursing program website, or the stand-alone document with the holistic criteria listed.</i>
Step 3:	Complete the Special Program Application by the Deadline - Fall Semester: Application available March 1st - April 15th - Spring Semester: Application available September 1st - October 15th

Minimum Requirements to be Considered for Admission:

- Completion of required pre-requisite courses with grades C or higher.
- A 2.75 or higher GPA in the four required pre-requisite courses.
- A valid (current version) Assessment Technology Institute (ATI) Test for Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) exam score on file by the application deadline.

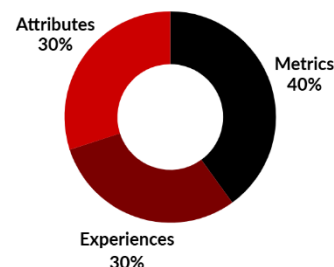
IMPORTANT DISCLAIMER ABOUT ADMISSIONS

This is a competitive and holistic application process. The criteria listed above are the minimum eligibility requirements to apply to the program. Admission is **not** guaranteed by completing the minimum eligibility requirements.

Holistic Admissions:

Applicants are scored through a holistic admissions review which includes these three components:

1. **Metrics** (Pre-requisite GPA and TEAS score) - 40%
2. **Experiences** (formal education, service and lived experiences essays and short-answer questions) - 30%
3. **Attributes** (intellectual curiosity, training, certifications, teamwork and collaboration, beliefs and values essays and short-answer questions) - 30%
